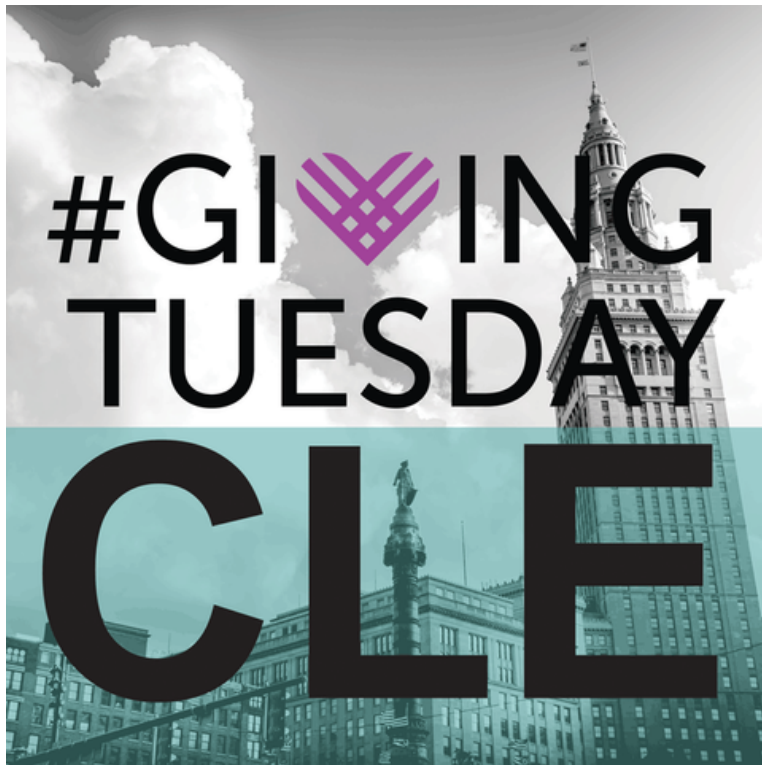

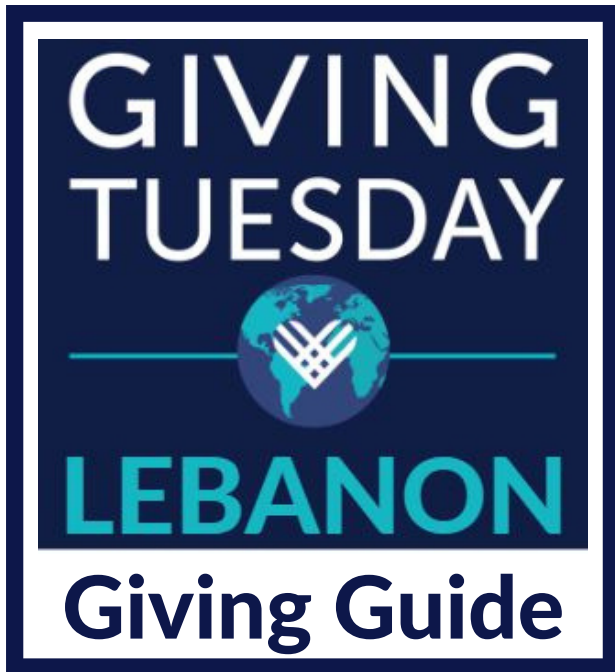

#GivingTuesdayNow Campaign

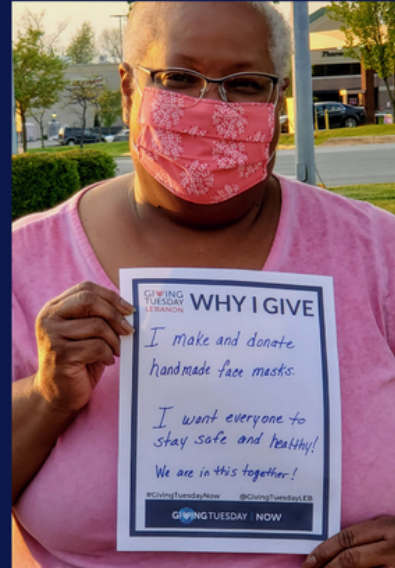
- A global day of giving and unity, set to take place on May 5, 2020 as an emergency response to the unprecedented need caused by COVID-19.

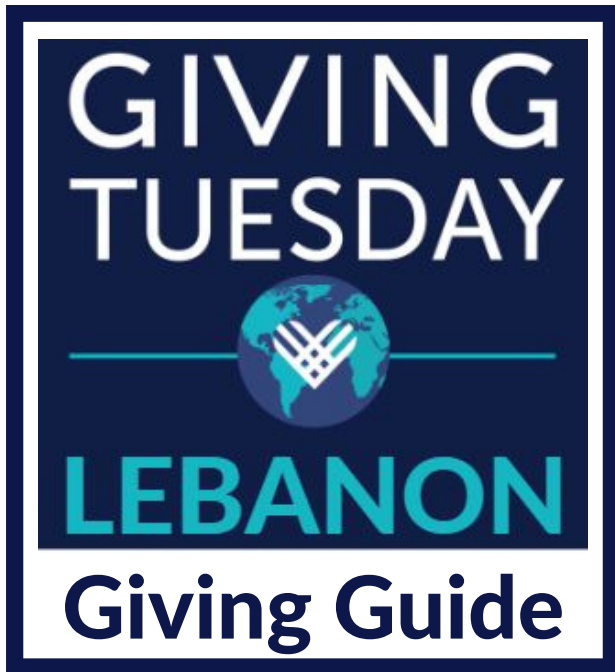
